## INTRODUCTION

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in twenty-two counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2025) by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 7,953 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming – 2025<sup>1</sup> report.
